Copying and pasting cells from one worksheet to another would be tedious if you are working with a large spreadsheet. But with Excel, this task is easy with just a few mouse clicks.





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
1. Open the workbook that contains the worksheet(s) that you want to move or copy [Source] and the worksheet where you want it to be copied/moved to [Destination].



2. Select the worksheet [from the source] that you want to move or copy. Then right-click the selected sheet tab and choose **M**ove or **C**opy... on the shortcut menu.





3. When the **Move or Copy** window appears, use the **To book** dropdown to select the workbook that you want to copy the worksheet to [destination workbook]. Check the **Create a copy** checkbox.



4. Click OK. You will now have the same worksheet in both workbooks.
