

1. Go to the *View* tab and click on *Slide Master*.




2. Click on Page Setup icon.




3. Here you can use the available presets or customize the setting.

AVAILABLE PRESETS



Refer to the table below for the different types of resolutions/aspect ratios available in the Page Setup dialog box.

Slide Size	Description
4:3 (On-screen Show)	Default display size for PowerPoint Presentations. This size is used by older models of TV screens and projectors.
16:9 (On-screen Show)	Also known as Widescreen show. This size is used in high-definition television and is a video widescreen standard.
16:10 (On-screen Show)	Almost similar with the 16:9 slides size. The only difference is its ratio with the height is greater than the 16:9 slides size.
Succeeding sizes (Letter Paper, Ledger Paper, A3 and A4 Paper, etc.)	Displayed sizes will be similar to measurements indicated in the dropdown list of the Page Setup dialog box.
