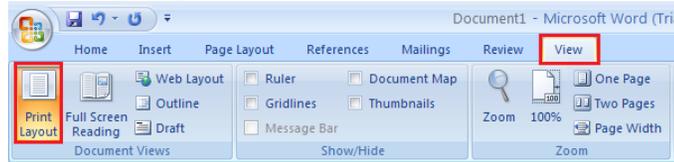

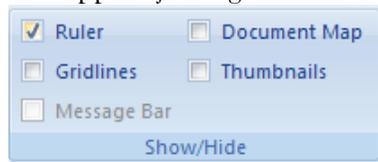
Show the Ruler in Kingsoft Writer 2013

MS Word 2007

1. From the menu, click on **View** tab. Select **Print Layout** in **Document Views** group.



2. In the **Show/Hide** group, tick the **Ruler** check box.
The horizontal ruler will appear just right above the document page.

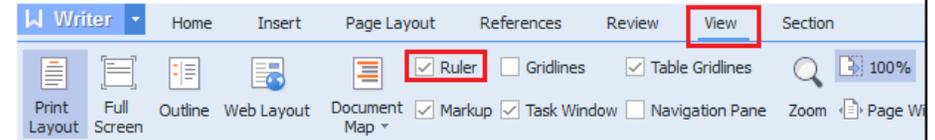


3. To display the vertical ruler, click the **Office Button** > **Word Options**.

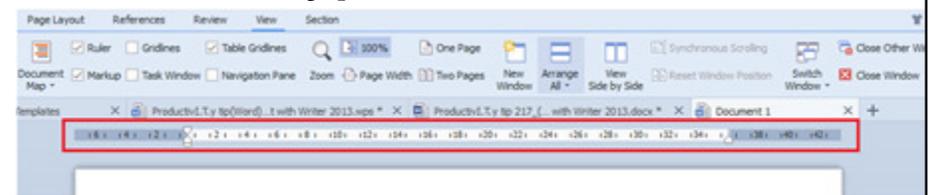

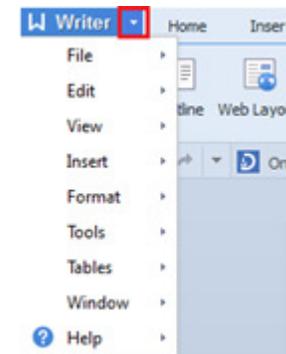
1. Click on **View** then tick the **Ruler** check box.



2. Upon clicking the check box, horizontal ruler will appear just right above the document page.



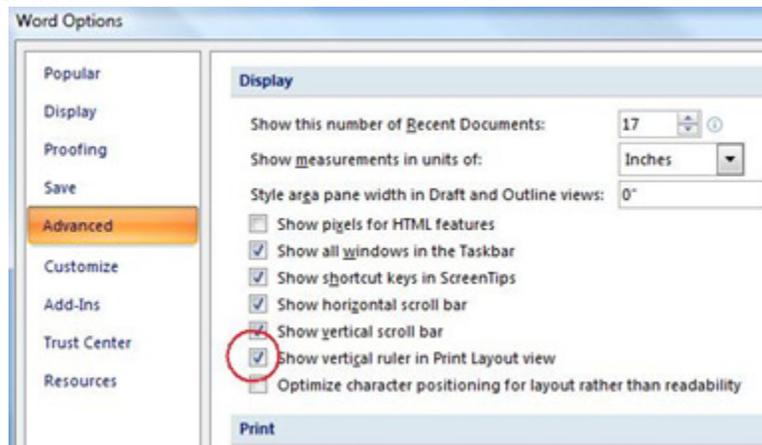
3. To display the vertical ruler on the left side of the document page, click on the arrow down button on the **Writer** menu.



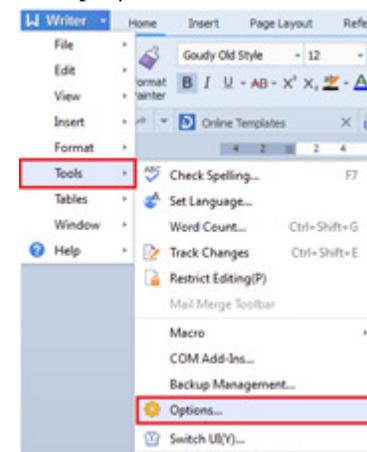
4. Select the **Advance** tab, scroll down to the **Display** section.



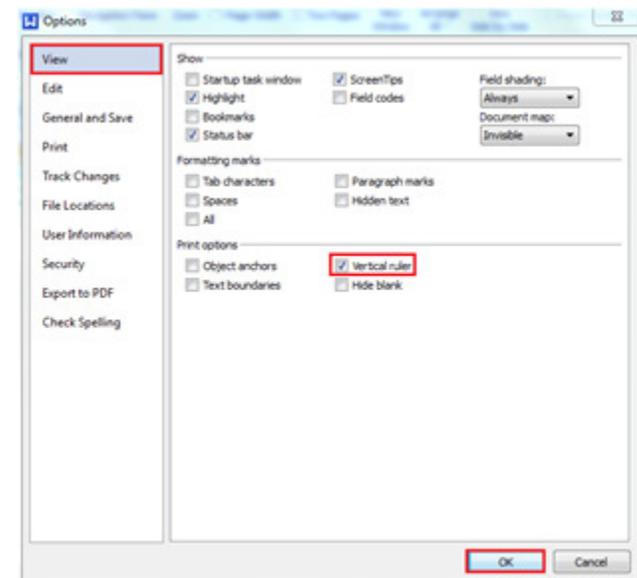
5. Tick the **Show vertical ruler in Print Layout view** check box. Click **OK**.
